You are about to create your own Constitution PowerPoint. The PowerPoint will explain the major parts of the Constitution with words and illustrations. In addition, this PowerPoint will help you understand how the Constitution affects your own life in a variety of ways. You will use your notes, textbook, class discussion, and the internet to complete the content in this PowerPoint.

Several periods of class time will be devoted to the completion of this Constitution PowerPoint, however there will be portions of the assignment that will have to be completed at home. We will use Google Drive to complete this activity.

It is imperative that you come to class prepared. You must bring the materials you will need to work on your Constitution PowerPoint each day. No student should waste class time saying he or she will complete the work at home. Each class period given as work time will be worth participation points, and you will receive points based on how well you use your time.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. **Every slide of your PowerPoint must have an illustration.** All pictures must be appropriate for the content of the slide (clip art or pictures from the web are acceptable).
2. PowerPoint must have a cover slide that includes a title, group members' names, and an appropriate illustration
3. PowerPoint must have a table of contents slide
4. The information on each slide **must be factual**
5. Each of the 11 slides must have a background
6. Each of the 11 slides must have **no more than two** animations per slide
 - a. Custom animation: effects, entrance, exit, motion path, etc.
 - b. Animation Schemes: bounce, fade, compress, etc.
7. Slide transitions and action buttons are optional, but encouraged **periodically**
